Operators Report

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The flow meter demonstration discussed at the last Meeting was changed to the 15<sup>th</sup> in Lonoke Ar , but The Company has made arrangements with me to Ship the meter to me and it should be here by Friday. Upon its arrival I will figure out how to use the meter And we will have a demonstration. I will call all of The Board members so that anyone who wishes to be At the demonstration can be there.

The Steel Creek Ext. Plans are still with the Ar Dept. Of Health and there has been no word yet.

On the 26<sup>th</sup> of Feb I found a large leak that I measured at the observation meter by well no 1 And clocked 120 gpm. After about 2hrs of searching I found the leak on the side line that feeds the old Don Deam House. When I arrived home one of my messages informed me that Harold Taylor has a Pressure guage and it fell to 13 pounds. A 2 inch Line blew up in the air at a coupling because the day Before the county grader had finally graded all but 2 inches of dirt off the line . The surrounding land showed about 18 inches had been permanently removed and when he angle bladed the ditch about 6 inches below the road level our line was left without sufficient cover. We lost a little over 100,000 gallons of water. The repair consisted of running 100 feet of

new trench and dropping the line 18 inches deeper and adding about 2 foot of pipe.

Uana Bunch had a leak past her meter and I clocked it at 140 gallons per day.

The two popoff valves for the fire station are on Order and they didn't know when they would arrive.

I checked the Low Gap area for a reported water leak but it was from the Fiber Optic highway bore And not our water.
