This letter is in response to your guidance regarding high radium levels found in our current water sources. Shelden Engineering has been retained to assist the Mount Sherman Water Association in developing a solution to this problem.

Due to concerns of potentially devastating high treatment costs to adequately treat our current water sources (2 deep wells) the Mount Sherman Water Board would like to investigate developing a new water supply source. The Mount Sherman Water Association requests a time extension to prepare a feasibility study to develop an alternate water source. The length of time extension required and possible water source alternates shall be determined in coordination with you.

Your response and further guidance is anticipated in this matter.
